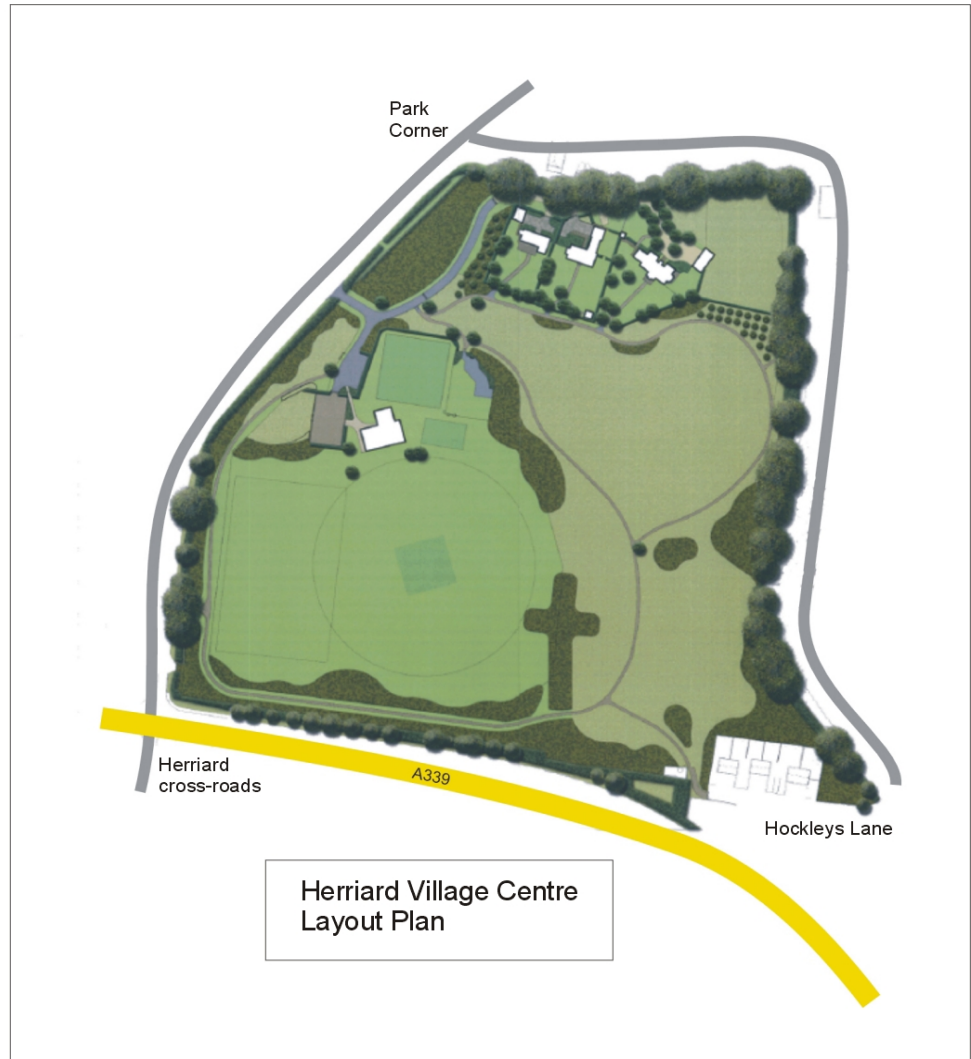


HERRIARD VILLAGE CENTRE PARISH ANNUAL MEETING 22nd APRIL

After over 10 years work we are delighted to announce that we have now signed agreements and expect to start building works during April or early May.

The Herriard Village Charity obtained outline planning permission for 3 new houses, a new Pavilion, Sports Pitches and an open meadow area in 2007. Bewley Homes submitted detailed plans for the Houses and Pavilion and this was approved in June 2008. After completing legal agreements the Charity has sold the building land to Bewley in exchange for which they are building all the sports facilities, and associated landscaping, in addition to making a payment to the Charity which will be kept as a maintenance fund for the future.



The project has been organised by the Herriard Village Centre Committee and the designs and detailed plans are all as agreed and approved by this Committee after the village open meeting in 2005.

We have also been approached by "The Old Rectory Nursery School" based in Weston Patrick who are looking for a new home. The Parish Council and Village Centre Committee have agreed this would be a good addition to the village. Having discussed this with Herriard Sports Club planning permission has been applied for to extend the Pavilion which will then be shared, making good use of the new facilities.
