Herriard Village Centre update June 2009

The developers continue to make good progress, with the landscaping works still slightly ahead of schedule. You will notice that access to the site has been formed and hedging cleared to improve the sight lines.

The communal areas have now largely been formed, seeded, and fenced and further planting will take place in the autumn/winter. Likewise the playing fields have been levelled and drainage will be installed within the next few weeks.



Work is slightly behind on the Pavilion, as it was decided to put it on hold until Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council had reached a decision on the nursery extension. However, we are delighted that the proposals have now been approved and the developers are confident that the lost time can be made up. In the first instance, foundations are due to be poured this week.



Unfortunately, two weeks ago, there was a serious theft on the site and the Police are now involved. Security has been improved significantly but it is obviously in everyone's best interests to be vigilant and to report any suspicious activity to the Police.

For health and safety reasons the site will be secured as much as possible but we must respectfully remind all parishioners not to venture on site without prior permission.
